The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.173, dated 14.07.2019, under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 (Section 67 of the IT Act was added lateron) registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

On the last date of hearing, this Court had been apprised that the matter had been amicably settled between the parties, thereafter the petitioner had been directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, states that in compliance of order dated 13.09.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 13.09.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
