The matter is being taken up through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amit Jhanji, Sr. Advocate with Mr. Abhishek Kumar, Advocate, takes notice on behalf of 2nd respondent.

Heard, Mr. H.P.S. Ghuman, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Amit Jhanji, Sr. Advocate with Mr. Abhishek Kumar, Advocate, appearing for 2nd respondent.

The petitioner's grievance is that though the petitioner's son was seriously injured with a *gandasa* blow on his forehead in an incident said to have occurred on 12.10.2021, the 3rd respondent has wrongly shown the said injury as one having been caused by a blunt instrument in the MLR , though to the naked eye, it is obvious that there was a cut on the forehead with a sharp edge weapon. The petitioner therefore, seeks a direction to the 2nd respondent to conduct an impartial medical examination on the said injury on the forehead of her son opining about the nature of the injury.

Mr. Jhanji appearing for the 2nd respondent states that 2nd respondent would constitute a Medical Board of three doctors to conduct physical medical examination of the son of the petitioner and record the opinion of the said Board regarding the nature of the injury suffered by the petitioner, if the petitioner's son is directed to appear before the Medical Superintendent of the 2nd respondent on 18.10.2021 at 11.00 am.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the petitioner to produce her son before the Medical Superintendent of 2nd respondent-Institution on 18.10.2021 at 11.00 am and the 2nd respondent is then directed to constitute a Medical board of three doctors for examining the petitioner's son and record its opinion regarding the nature of the injury suffered by him and furnish a copy of the said report to the petitioner or her son.

The writ petition, is accordingly, disposed of.
