Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(A) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for grant of three weeks' emergency parole to the petitioner on account of medical condition of his father.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide judgment and order dated 10.02.2014, the petitioner has been convicted under Sections 148, 302, 307, 465, 468, 471 read with Section 149, Section 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and has been sentenced to undergo life imprisonment. The appeal preferred by the petitioner was dismissed by the

Co-ordinate bench of this Court on 10.11.2017. Learned counsel further submits that earlier also the petitioner was granted parole but he absented for one day and vide order dated 19.6.2018, he was convicted for three years by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar and since then he has been in jail.

I have gone through the status report filed by the Superintendent of Prison, District Prison, Karnal, along with its Annexures, and as per Annexure R-T-IV, Sahab Singh-father of the petitioner is suffering from Piles disease and getting treatment from Dr. Somnath while staying at his own house and is also to be operated.

At this, learned State counsel points out that Rajkumar-other son of Sahab Singh, real brother of the petitioner, who is a driver by profession, can look after his father.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed, as no ground is made out to grant the concession of parole to the petitioner.
