Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respective parties submit that the parties have orally settled their dispute and according to the oral settlement, the claimant will be paid a sum of ₹3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lacs Only) over and above the amount of ₹12,14,600/- already awarded by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Ferozepur. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Insurance Company submits that the amount of ₹3,00,000/- will be paid to the claimants within a period of four weeks from today.

As the parties have already settled their dispute in an oral agreement, the same may be implemented and the present appeal is disposed of with the direction that keeping in view the oral settlement between the parties, another sum of ₹3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lacs Only) over and above the amount of ₹12,14,600/- already awarded by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Ferozepur be released in favour of the claimants within a period of four weeks from today. As undertaken by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Insurance Company, amount be released through

RTGS.

The claimants are directed to supply their bank details to the Insurance Company within a period of one week from today so that the awarded amount can be deposited within the time fixed hereinbefore.

Learned counsel for the appellants has informed that during the pendency of this appeal, 50% of the compensation was stayed and it is lying in the Tribunal. The Tribunal is directed to release the remaining amount of compensation to the appellants.
