The instant petition under Articles 226/227 has been preferred seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection of life and liberty and security to the petitioners, who alleged to have been living together since 10.10.2021.

Learned State counsel has filed a short affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police Guhla, District Kaithal and has referred to Para-3 of the said reply which reads as under:-

“That on receiving the notice of present petition, the matter is enquired again and the statements of petitioners and private respondents were recorded. The respondents No.4 to 6 have stated that the petitioner No.2 went with petitioner No.1 to roam at Chandigarh and has already been returned at home and there they filed petition for security but now both the petitioners are living separately at their own home with their parents respectively. They have no need to any security.

The petitioner No.1 stated that he was in friendship with petitioner No.2. On 10.10.2021 he took her at Chandigarh with intent to marriage. There they filed petition before Hon'ble High Court for security. After that they went to their home. They did not solemnize marriage. They do not need any security.

The similar statement has been given by the petitioner No.2”.

In the light of the statement made above and faced with the fact that there is no threat perception to the petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he does not want to pursue the present petition and wishes to withdraw the same.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
