The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.170 dated 22.08.2020, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC, registered at Police Station Kabarwala, district Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner and the daughter of the complainant are living together. They have approached the Punjab Human Rights Commission and have been granted protection by order dated 28.08.2020 (Annexure P-2).

This Court by the order dated 27.11.2020 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 27.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
