The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 108 dated 14.07.2019 under Sections 498-A, 323 IPC registered at Police Station 1, Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on instructions of this Court he has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmit Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated qua the petitioner and the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 26.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
