Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 has already been arrested and therefore, the present petition is not being pressed qua the said petitioner No.1. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioners No. 2 to 7 intend to surrender before the trial Court and the only direction needed is that in case, petitioners No. 2 to 7 surrender before the trial Court and file bail application, the same be decided expeditiously.

In respect of the prayer of petitioners No. 2 to 7 for issuing direction to the trial Court for deciding the bail application expeditiously, this Court has no apprehension that in case bail application is filed by petitioners No. 2 to 7, the same will be decided by the trial Court as expeditiously as possible keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case.

Keeping in view the above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners No. 2 to 7 be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and apply for bail.
