GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.0024 dated 01.04.2019, registered at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 336, 506, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC (Section 326 of the IPC added later on) and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, wherein allegations have been levelled against the accused to the effect that they have caused injuries to Jagjit Singh.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has since been amicably resolved between the parties and that the complainant does not have any objection for grant of bail to the petitioner.

3. Although the learned State counsel has opposed the petition, but Shri Arjun Chaudhary, Advocate, who appears on behalf of the complainant has admitted the factum of compromise and has stated that he has no objection for grant of bail to the petitioner.
4. In view of the aforesaid position wherein the matter seems to have been amicably resolved, the petition is accepted and in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
