Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in live-in relationship against the wishes of respondents No. 4 and 5 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. It is submitted that petitioner No. 1-Jaspreet Kaur is major and petitioner No. 2 Rahul, is minor as date of birth is 25.05.2004 and they apprehend danger at the hands of private respondents No. 4 and 5 who will eliminate them if they intent to solemnize the marriage after the petitioner

No. 2 attained the marriageable age.

The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 11.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, Punjab.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. H.S. Multani, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 only. He informed this Court that the statement of petitioner No. 1-Jaspreet Kaur was recorded by ASI Rajdeep on 02.11.2021 wherein petitioner No. 1 has specifically mentioned that there is no threats perceptions to both the petitioners.

Keeping in view of the above, the present petitioner stands disposed of.
