The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the revised pension and other retiral benefits to the petitioner on the basis of last pay drawn by him at the time of his retirement with all consequential benefits along with interest @ 12% p.a. in terms of Annexure P3, P4, P6 and P7 as well as to decide the legal notice dated 22.06.2021 (Annexure P-8).
