Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to to respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to conduct a free and impartial investigation in FIR No. 161 dated 16.08.2021, registered under Sections 302/34 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Kathu Nangal, District Amritsar Rural and incorporate respondent Nos. 5 to 7 as accused in the said FIR.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the last date of hearing, none has appeared for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, submits that two accused namely Prabh Dayal Singh @ Sunny and Harpreet @ Sheru were declared as juvenile and two other accused namely Vishaldeep Singh and Manga were arrested and challan qua them was presented on 15.11.2021. It is further submitted that respondent No. 5 Gurmej Singh (Geja) was nominated as an accused on 18.10.2021 under

Section 29 of the Arms Act and respondent Nos. 6 and 7 were found innocent in the inquiry conducted by Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition and the same is disposed of.

However, it will be open for the petitioner to raise all the pleas and arguments at the time of framing of charge and move an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C., if so advised.
