The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.175 dated 13.10.2020, under Sections 364, 379-B, 307, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City South, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR wherein 04 co-accused have been named and they have been arrested. The petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of the co-accused, who has alleged that the petitioner had caused rod blow on the arm of the complainant. The petitioner is 21 years of age and is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court, by the order dated 27.11.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City, Moga, District Moga wherein it is stated that the petitioner has joined investigation and the iron rod allegedly used by him has been recovered.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 27.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
