On 15.11.2021, the following order had been recorded by this

Court:-

“Vide this application, the mother of the petitioner in the accompanying petition seeks to withdraw this petition with her appearing in person.

The petitioner is shown to be 27 years of age and stated to be confined in Central Jail, Ludhiana.

Notice in the application, with Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepting notice on behalf of the respondent State, on the asking of the court.

Adjourned to 23.11.2021.

He would take instructions as to whether the petitioner himself, being of the age of majority, wishes to withdraw the petition or not.

To be shown in the urgent motion list.”

With the petitioners' mother having again appeared before this

Court on 23.11.2021 seeking to withdraw the petition and this Court having directed the Superintendent of the Central Jail, Ludhiana, to get an affidavit of the petitioner filed stating as to whether he wishes to withdraw the petition or not, the affidavit has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, dated 08.12.2021, annexing therewith an affidavit of the petitioner (Sanpreet Narang), also dated 08.12.2021, shown to be thumb marked by the petitioner and attested by the Deputy Superintendent of the said jail.

Paragraph 3 of the said affidavit reads as follows:-

“That I wants to withdraw the present petition as the I want some addition in the petition and also wants to place on record some additional documents and hence I may be permitted to withdraw the same as I want to file a fresh petition for grant of regular bail with better particulars.”

That being so, the application bearing No. CRM-38499-2021 is allowed and the petition(CRM-M-44511-2021) is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn, with no comment made by this Court on the merits of the case.

The affidavit of the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ludhiana, annexing therewith the affidavit of the petitioner, is ordered to be taken on record.
