1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.207, dated 30.8.2020, Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on).

2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion the following order was passed on 2.12.2020:

“The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that none of the petitioner is attributed any grievous injury and that while Amarjit Kaur (petitioner) was empty handed, Sarabjit Kaur is alleged to have given a brick bat blow and Resham Kumar is alleged to have given blow with a base ball bat. It has been submitted that the grievous injury is attributed to nonapplicant Sukhdev Raj @ Mintu.

Notice of motion for 17.3.2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

3. The learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Rajinder Kumar, has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.
4. In view of the aforestated position wherein the petitioners has joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 2.12.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and

shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2)
Cr.P.C.
