AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Having heard the counsel for the petitioner and on going through the impugned order dated 07.10.2021 passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Panchkula, there appears to be no justification on the part of the petitioner to have delayed the proceedings on one pretext or the other, however, in the light of the fact that the petitioner is ready and willing to file his affidavit along with the documents of his income tax returns, income certificate and the certificate of the employer, one more opportunity is granted to the petitioner to do the same by appearing before the trial Court today or at the most tomorrow, subject to payment of Rs.50,000/- as costs to the respondent-wife today itself. This is being done for the reason that the filing of these documents will facilitate and expedite the decision in the pending matter before the trial Court.

Liberty is also granted to the petitioner to cross-examine the witnesses, who would appear before the Court as per the orders which have been earlier passed by the Family Court.

The present petition stands disposed of in above terms.

In case there is any difficulty with regard to the aspects, as have

been pointed out by this Court, the trial Court shall adjourn the matter for a short date so that the interest of the parties is secured.

Copy of this order be given *dasti* to the counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court as the matter is listed for hearing before the trial Court today i.e. 18.10.2021.
