The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action against accused persons for causing injuries to the petitioner or to register an FIR against them and to decide representation dated 12.11.2020 (Annexure P-4) made by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala with further directions to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from danger at the hands of accused persons.

Learned State counsel has submitted that FIR No. 104 dated 31.12.2020 has been registered on the basis of said representation and the present petition has become infructuous.

This factual position is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
