This is an application for disposing of the main writ petition as infructuous in view of the office signal dated 25.11.2021, vide which the transfer of the petitioner has been cancelled.

Notice in the application.

Mr. Anantdeep Singh Sandhu, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/petitioner and submits that he has no objection, if the present application is allowed.

For the reasons mentioned in the application and in view of the no objection given by the counsel for the petitioner, the application is allowed as prayed for. Accordingly, hearing of the main petition is preponed and the same is taken up today itself for final hearing.

Main Case

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing of the order dated 13.09.2018 (Annexure P-1), passed by respondent No.3, vide which the petitioner has been transferred and against the standing order No.7/2015 dated 04.08.2015 (Annexure P-2), with a further prayer to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to not to transfer the petitioner from present place of posting and to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 15.09.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the transfer order of the petitioner has since been withdrawn. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

This factual aspect has not been disputed by the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous.

All pending miscellaneous applications are also disposed of as such.
