The grouse of the petitioner is that though FIR No.0158 dated 4.8.2020, under Sections 304 and 120-B IPC has been registered with Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda with regard to murder of her son but the investigation is not being conducted properly inasmuch as respondent No.5 – Sethi Thekedar (real name Surinder Kumar Sethi), who is the main culprit has not been arrested and is roaming about freely. Though the petitioner had filed a similar petition bearing CRM-M-19522-2020, in which adequate directions had been issued vide order dated 28.8.2020 but those are not being complied with in letter and spirit by the local police authorities.

Notice of motion.

Mr.J.S. Ghuman, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 4. He on instructions of ASI Charanjit Singh has stated that on completion of investigation, challan against two accused i.e. Jasvir Singh @ Seera Singh and Jagtar Singh @ Sapri (respondents No.6 and 7) has since been filed in the Court, whereas respondent No.5 – Surinder Kumar Sethi, Thekedar was found to innocent and has not been challaned.

After hearing the statement, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would seek his remedy for summoning of Surinder Kumar Sethi, Thekedar as additional accused by moving application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. in the trial Court and take recourse to other remedies available to him under the law and he does not press the present petition.

Dismissed being not pressed.
