The present order shall dispose of 5 writ petitions i.e. **CWP Nos.20405, 21007, 22049, 22181 & 22424 of 2020**, which have been filed seeking directions for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to stay the final recruitment/scrutiny of documents against the post of Sports and School Special Assistant, which was made against Memo No.20/71-2020 dated 12.11.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Counsel for the State submits that in view of the order passed in **CWP No.21742 of 2020 'Tejpal and others Vs. State of Haryana and others'** decided on 15.01.2021, the methodology of recruitment for the post of Sports and School Special Assistant, which is subject matter of challenge, has been dropped.

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It is brought to the notice of the Court that thereafter Public Notice dated 25.01.2021 has been issued for the said purpose.

It is not disputed that the same is also subject matter of consideration in CWP Nos.2658 and 2989 of 2021, fixed for today.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above, the present writ petitions are disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
