HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner is that he was stabbed by the private respondents, which fact is corroborated by the hospital reports and the MLR given by a Government institution but still no action is being taken by the police authorities though a representation dated 28.09.2021 (Annexure P-4) to the said fact has already been given by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural). Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to decide the representation dated 28.09.2021 (Annexure P-4) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 28.09.2021 (Annexure P-4) by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 28.09.2021 (Annexure P-4), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 28.09.2021 (Annexure P-4) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated in case, before deciding the representation, hearing to the private respondents No. 4 to 10 is also afforded so as to ascertain the correct facts.
