This order shall dispose of a bunch of writ petitions including CWP-20401-2020, CWP-20408-2020, CWP-20409-2020, CWP-20410-2020, CWP-20416-2020, CWP-20419-2020, CWP-20421-2020, CWP-20422-2020, CWP-20425-2020 and CWP-20517-2020.

The issue in these connected writ petitions is with regard to implementation of the online Transfer Policy in respect of Junior Engineers under the Development and Panchayats Department, State of Haryana.

On the previous date of hearing, this Court had been informed that the matter was pending before a Grievance Redressal Forum.

Mr. Sharan Sethi, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has today informed the Court that the Grievance Redressal Forum has since examined the grievance/claim of each one of the petitioners in these bunch of petitions and has made certain recommendations and which have now been placed before the competent authority to take a final view.

Learned State counsel furnishes an assurance that the final decision with regard to transfer of the petitioners would be taken within a period of two weeks from today.

In the light of such categorical stand taken on behalf of the State, writ petitions are disposed of.
