The petitioner seeks grant of parole for construction/repair of his house as well as for sowing *Rabbi* crop.

In the reply filed by the State, it has been mentioned that the petitioner had not furnished the documents pertaining to agricultural land owned by him to support his case for grant of agricultural parole or for repair of his house.

Faced with the aforestated position, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to file an application afresh for seeking parole.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioner would, however, be at liberty to move an application afresh for grant of parole for construction/repair of his house or for agricultural purposes provided the same is accompanied by

supporting documents. In case, any such application is filed, the same shall be disposed of expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of such application.
