Petitioner apprehends danger to her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 (private respondents).

Highlighting this aspect, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 14.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar Mohali-respondent No. 2.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar Mohali-respondent No. 2 and the

Station House Officer, Police Station Dhakoli, District S.A.S. Nagar Mohali-respondent No. 3 to look into the representation dated 14.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and in case some substance is found therein, steps, in accordance with law, be initiated to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized in any manner at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5, except in accordance with law.

It is made clear that in case of violation of any law by the petitioner, the law will take its own course and this order shall not be treated as an impediment of any nature in the investigation or process involved as per the Statute and law.
