Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life and property of the petitioner and his family from the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 26.

Counsel submits that as a result of altercation, which took place on 09.07.2021, the petitioner sustained injuries and an FIR bearing No.0271 dated 10.07.2021 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, Annexure P-1, has been registered at Police Station Sadar Nuh, on the complaint of Jakir S/o Abdul, naming 22 persons as accused. Counsel submits that 9 persons

had been inflicted injuries by the accused and the accused are threatening the petitioner to withdraw the criminal case. He submits that before approaching this Court, petitioner has submitted representations (Annexure P-5) to respondents No. 3 and 4, which have not been attended to and the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to examine the same.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Mewat, District Mewat – respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 08.10.2021 (Annexure P-5 at pages 68-69 of the paper-book) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law, in case any substance is found in the same.

A copy of this order as well as representation dated 08.10.2021 be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
