The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 251 dated 19.07.2020, registered under Sections 324/323/34 of the IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

The operative part of the order dated 02.12.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“....Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, registered on the statement of Gouri Shankar, it is stated that when he was working in his fields, petitioners came there and caused injuries to him.

It is further submitted that injury, invoking Section 326 IPC, is attributed to co-accused Bittu.

Learned counsel further submits that without any prejudice to their right of defence, the petitioners are ready to compensate the complainant for his medical

expenses by paying an amount of Rs. 5,000/- each.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 02.12.2020, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have deposited the amount of Rs.5,000/- each.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 02.12.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
