Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.50 dated 03.07.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

By virtue of the order dated 06.09.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. He further submits that she is already paying Rs.10,000/- per month and she is also offering one of the house out of three to the complainant. However, she herself is not ready

to come and reside in the same.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that though Rs.10,000/- per month is being given, however, regarding the house there is still a dispute. However, the complainant is also ready to accept the house offered by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the fact of joining investigation by the petitioner and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 06.09.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.

The parties are at liberty to carry on their negotiations and settle their dispute to their convenience.
