This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.731 dated 04.08.2017 under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149 and 414 of the IPC, 1860; Section 25 and 29 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and the Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar, Haryana.

On the last date there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Even today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate and as per the same, the petitioner is involved in 5 more FIRs, apart from the present FIR.

Learned State counsel submits that out of 29 prosecution witnesses, 27 prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the trial is likely to be concluded.

Learned State counsel further submits that the allegations against petitioner-Parveen Saini are that he along with co-accused Shankar opened fire

and caused fatal injuries to Sunil, Sachin and Vinod. Consequent to which, Sachin died at the spot, whereas Sunil and Vinod were taken to the hospital, where Sunil also died.

Learned State counsel further submits that Vinod has duly supported the prosecution version while appearing as prosecution witness.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I find no ground to grant the concession of regular bail to petitioner.

The present petition is dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within a period of 09 months from today.
