This is the third petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.235, dated 12.12.2019 registered under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, “NDPS Act”), at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

A perusal of the status report filed by the State shows the involvement of the petitioner in as many as eight cases, out of which he stands convicted in 4 cases, all of which were registered for offences under the provisions of NDPS Act.

Concession of bail is not meant for an accused who habitually indulges in trade of banned intoxicants.

Petition is dismissed.
