The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent authorities to release pensionary/retiral benefits under the Pepsu Road Transport Corporation Employees Pension/Gratuity and General Provident Fund Regulation 1992 from the date the petitioner retired and pay all arrears alongwith interest @ 12% per annum, for which, representation dated 16.01.2020

(Annexure P-8) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider representation dated 16.01.2020 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
