This is a criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents no.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent no.4 for not harassing the petitioner.

Notice of motion was issued.

Today Mr.Deepak Arora, Advocate along with respondent no.4 Happy has put in appearance.

Learned counsel for respondent no.4, on instructions from Happy-respondent no.4 who is present in Court, has submitted that respondent no.4 would not harass the petitioner in any way and will not interfere in her life.

Respondent no.4 present in the Court has stated that he

undertakes that he would not in any way harass the petitioner.

In view of the statement of respondent no.4 made in the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is satisfied and thus, the present petition be disposed of as infructuous.

In view of the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
