The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.143, dated 02.10.2021, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron) at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar.

By an order dated 21.10.2021, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State has filed reply in court today, which is taken on record. She, on instructions from SI Mohan Lal, submits that petitioner has joined investigation, however, there is an objection that *gandasi* used in the offence is not recovered.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 21.10.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
