The instant petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case registered or likely to be registered at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar on the basis of complaint No.2046 dated 07.09.2021 lodged by respondent No.5

Learned counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer that respondent-State should be directed to comply with the provisions of Sections 41-A and 160 Cr.P.C. and to give an advance notice of at least 7 days, in case the petitioners are required to be called in connection with the complaint filed by respondent No.5.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Mr. C.L. Pawar, Sr. DAG Punjab, who is present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the limited prayer made, the instant petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondent-State that in the event of arrest of the petitioners in connection with the complaint filed by respondent No.5, a seven days notice well in advance and in writing shall be served upon the petitioners to enable them to avail their legal remedies in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
