Status report filed by way of affidavit of Sh.Pradeep Dahiya, District Magistrate, Kaithal, is taken on record.

It has been stated in the status report that a raid was conducted on the brick kiln by a team and it has been reported that there is no dispute of the alleged detenus with the brick kiln owner and they were never kept bonded by owner of brick kiln and all basic amenities are provided by the brick kiln owner and brick kiln is open from all sides.

Relevant portion of para 3 of the status report reads as under:-

“All the private respondents mentioned in the said writ petition were found on the brick kiln during the inspection. The private respondents along with petitioner and his family members made joint statement that all of

them came along with their families to the said brick kiln for work of pather as per their own will about one month earlier. Now the weather on the brick kiln is not suitable to them so they want to go home along with the families. There is no dispute with the brick kiln owner. They were never kept bonded by owner of brick kiln. All basic amenities are provided by the brick kiln owner and the brick kiln is open from all sides. Now we are going to our native place along with families and luggages willfully.”

In view of the status report filed by the State, no cause of action survives in the present petition and accordingly the same is hereby dismissed.
