Prayer in this petition is for issuance of the directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the instance of respondents No.5 to 7.

It is submitted that the petitioner is serving in Indian Army and his mother has moved a complaint against respondents No.5 to 7 before the Illaqa Magistrate at Tarn Taran and the private respondents are putting undue pressure on the family of the petitioner to withdraw the complaint elsewhere, they may be involved in some false case.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tarn Taran dated 04.02.2021 as well as SI Devender Kumar i.e. respondent No.7 are on record.

As per the reply filed by the State, it is submitted that the complaint given by the petitioner on 21.01.2020 was marked to ASI Dilbag Singh for conducting an enquiry and during the enquiry, the petitioner and others came and made a statement that the matter has

been resolved and they do not want to pursue the complaint.

Reply of the petitioner – Gurjit Singh is attached as Annexure R-2 and the General Diary No.025 dated 22.01.2020 in this regard is relied upon as Annexure R-3. It is also stated that thereafter, the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tarn Tarn has submitted a report to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran (Annexure R-4), highlighting the facts and circumstances as well as the fact that the petitioner himself has stated that he do not want to pursue the complaint.

Similar stand is taken in the separate reply filed by SI Devender Kumar that in performance of the duty was assigned the enquiry which was later on marked to the other Investigating Officer.

In view of the above, no further action is called for.

Disposed of, accordingly.
