Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.201 dated 26.07.2020 under Sections 460, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, 1860, and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals(Regulations) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station A-Division Amritsar, District Amritsar.
