RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Rupesh Aggarwal, Sub Divisional Magistrate (South), U.T., Chandigarh, submits that respondent-authorities have now decided to withdraw the order dated 16.10.2021 by which premises of the petitioner was sealed. He further submits that in view of the decision taken by the authorities, the premises of the petitioner shall be de-sealed today itself.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents and as the prayer made by the petitioner in the petition stands allowed and his premises shall be de-sealed today itself, nothing substantive survives in the petition and the same is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to avail such other remedies, as shall be admissible in law, against the respondent authorities.
