[1] At the outset, learned counsel prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation for release of annual increments to the petitioner for the period the petitioner remained under suspension and directions being issued to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the same on receipt in a time bound manner.

[2] Learned State Counsel on perusal of the writ petition, as well as reply filed states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

[3] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is permitted to be *withdrawn* with liberty to file a comprehensive representation before respondent No.1. In case, any such representation is received within 01 week from date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the same be considered and decided by respondent No.1 in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible.
