Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.178 dated 17.08.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Titram, District Kaithal.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 26.10.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has amicably been settled between the parties and relies upon compromise dated 12.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) in this regard...”

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Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for complainant-respondent No.2 and on instructions from SI Karanvir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation and also acknowledged that the matter has been compromised.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 26.10.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
