Petitioner Israr (convict) has filed this writ petition for issuance of directions to the respondents to release him on parole for eight weeks to enable him to arrange and attend the marriage function of his younger brother, which is scheduled for 04.11.2021.

Learned counsel for petitioner contends that the marriage ceremony of his younger brother is scheduled for 4.11.2021 and the copy of the invitation card is appended.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and opposes the prayer on the ground that the petitioner has already been convicted in number of cases.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that details of petitioner's conviction in six cases have already been given in para 1 of the petition.

Considering the above background, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for release of the petitioner on parole at this stage. However,

it is directed that the Superintendent Central Jail, Yamuna Nagar (Haryana) shall ensure that the petitioner is allowed to attend the wedding ceremony of his younger brother in custody. The expenses for travel, etc. shall be borne by the petitioner.

The petition is disposed off.
