The case has been taken up for hearing through
video-conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under
Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.133 dated
08.09.2020, registered under Sections 324, 34 IPC and Section
307 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Tibber, District
Gurdaspur.

As per the allegations, petitioner gave three datar
blows on the person of Gurpreet Singh. Gurpreet Singh raised
his left arm in order to save himself and the blows ultimately
landed on his left wrist. As per medico legal report, injuries

No.2, 3 and 4 were found on the left wrist of Gurpreet Singh and the same have been declared simple in nature.

The aforesaid fact is not in dispute as the learned State counsel admits that injuries No.2, 3 and 4 on the person of Gurpreet Singh are found to be simple in nature.

Notice of motion was issued on 14.12.2020 and arrest of the petitioner was also stayed till the next date of hearing i.e. till today.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 02.02.2021 at 11.00 A.M. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on anticipatory bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his/her passport, if any.
