1. The relevant portion of the Joint Inspection Report, existing in the reply on affidavit filed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Dera Bassi, on behalf of respondent No.2, District Mohali, is extracted hereinafter:-

“We on 2.11.2021 inspected the spot of the brick kiln S.S.B. village, Jaulakalan and Ashok S/o Jai Singh, Bajinder s/o Amar Singh, Vajinder s/o Bheem Ram, Rani w/o Ram Dass, Rashmi w/o Ashok, Anita w/o Ram Kumar, Anita w/o Varinder, Santi Singh s/o Ram Dass, Vansh Kumar s/o Ram Kumar and Nirdesh w/o Vajinder got recorded their joint statement that they were doing the work of labor at the brick kiln S.S.B. village Jaula Kalan and they have never been made to do bonded labor by the brick kiln owner and there is no barbed wire/boundary wall around their quarters, that they have been paid their requisite remuneration by the brick kiln owner and they had come on this brick kiln of their own accord and Will and now they

are leaving this brick kiln with their own Will.

Hence keeping in view the above statement I have reached at this conclusion that the labor has never been made to do bonded labor by the brick kiln owner at the brick kiln Marka S.S.B. village Jaula Kalan and the above labor had come to this brick kiln out of their own accord and Will and are now leaving with their own Will.”

2. A perusal of the above extracted relevant portion of the reply on the affidavit, discloses that the respondents concerned, have not committed any breach of any beneficial labour legislation.
3. Consequently, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
4. Permission granted.
5. The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
