Petitioners have filed this writ petition under Articles 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect their life and liberty from respondent Nos.4 to 10 as they have solemnized marriage on 27.11.2020 against their wishes.

On 03.12.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are receiving threats from respondent Nos.4 to 10 as they have entered into marriage on 27.11.2020 against the wishes of private respondents.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to forward the complete copy of the petition to the office of Advocate General Punjab through e-mail, during the course of the day.

Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts

and the existence of alleged threat.

On request, adjourned to 17.12.2020.”

Status report by way of affidavit of Varinder Pal Singh (PPS) Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Shahkot, Jalandhar on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed. Learned State counsel has apprised that statements of petitioner No.1 has been recorded wherein she has stated that she is residing happily in her matrimonial home and not facing any threat from the private respondents. Statements of private respondent Nos.5, 6 and 7 also have been recorded and stated that they have no objection to the alleged marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the above, petition is rendered infructuous.
