Through this revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner assails the correctness of the order passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, while dismissing an application for appointment of Local Commissioner to report about the possession.

Two Division Benches of this Court while examining this issue, on separate occasions, have held that such an order is not revisable. Reference in this regard can be made to '**Rajender Prasad vs. Santosh Kumar and others**' 1979 PLJ 562 and '**Malkiat Singh vs. Narinder Singh and another**' 1990(2) PLR 191.

In view of the binding precedents, the revision petition is disposed of as being not maintainable.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
