[1] Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through Video Conference.

[2] This writ petition was filed seeking directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as he is being threatened by respondents No.4 and 5 of his life, as also implication in false criminal cases.

[3] A representation dated 10th November, 2020 was filed with the Station House Officer, Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar.

[4] From the contents of the representation it is forthcoming that there are civil litigation pending between the parties, there is an interim direction granted.

[5] Notice of motion was issued.

[6] Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Sudesh Kumar submits that FIR No. 148, dated 24th August, 2021, under Sections 370, 448, 451, 148 and 149 IPC has been registered at Police Station Division

No.5, Jalandhar.

[7] Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a threat perception but the said issued has not been decided.

[8] In the representation there is no allegation of threat perception. There are no specific instances mentioned of threat perception. Merely a bald statement has been made in the petition.

[9] In view of above, no further direction is called for.

[10] The petition is disposed of.

[11] Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies for the redressal of his surviving grievances, if any.
