The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant notional promotion to the petitioner to the post of Service Engineer from the due date of promotion as well as to grant financial benefits i.e. revised pay and revised pension along with arrears and interest on delayed payment as the promotional committee has approved the name of petitioner to the post of Service Engineer and committee as well as Managing Director has signed that recommendation but respondent No.2 Chairman has kept the matter pending without any reason and has delayed in issuing formal order of promotion to the petitioner and in the meantime the petitioner retired on 29.02.2020.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the respondents to consider the representation dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-4) and legal notice dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
