Application for placing on record the affidavit of the petitioner in terms of the order dated 02.12.2021 is allowed. Affidavit of the petitioner is taken on record.

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The nature of order this Court proposes to pass would not go into the question of maintainability of the present petition.

After interacting with learned counsel for the parties, it is mutually agreed that till the petitioner avails legal recourses as may be available to her within a period of three months from today, the petitioner shall be permitted to meet her child in the academy on every alternative Sunday between 11.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon subject to the condition that she would be permitted to carry her daughter and under no circumstance, her husband would accompany there.

It is made clear that on the day of meeting, the care taker/warden would be present in the premises of academy. However, at the meeting place, they will not accompany them. In case, the child is not present or available on Sunday in the academy then such a meeting would take place in nearby good eating point. However, at the eating point, uncle

and aunt (Chacha and Chachi) i.e. respondents No.3 and 4 will be present in

the adjacent table within their view.

It is clarified that this liberty shall be valid till 28.03.2022 and in case, the petitioner chose to avail legal remedies as may be available to her then this order shall be substituted by the order passed by the concerned Court and in case, the petitioner do not opt to avail legal remedies, then this order shall remain into force till 28.03.2022.

With the aforesaid observations, the present petition is disposed of. It is clarified that the abovesaid observation will not come in the way of further proceedings in any manner whatsoever. It is further clarified that disposal of the present petition will not come in the way of filing of fresh petition.

Accordingly, the present petition and pending application(s) if any, stands disposed of.
