Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.502 dated 09.09.2020 initially registered under Sections 3, 7(i), 7(ii) of the Haryana Urban Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975 and Section 6 and 7(1) of the Punjab Schedule Roads and Controlled Areas Restrictions Unregulated Development Act of 1963 (added later on) at Police Station Azad Nagar, Hisar, District Hisar.

Notice of motion was issued on 03.12.2020 on the premise that the petitioners infact considered themselves to be the victims of Hissar Municipal Council Area Cooperative House Building Society. The Society had issued certificate of membership to petitioner No.1. The petitioners were given

impression that the land in question is free from all encumbrances and the allottees can raise construction thereupon. Even the petitioners were told that the Society has also applied for approval of the land and would get the same at the earliest. Infact no such application was ever moved by the Society under the Haryana Development and Regulations of Urban Areas Act, 1975. Interim protection was granted to the petitioners.

Thereafter vide order dated 05.02.2021, the petitioners were directed to join the the investigation on or before 19.02.2021.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ramesh submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and they are no more required for further investigation of the case..

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 05.02.2021 is made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
