This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., seeking 'regular bail' for the petitioner in case FIR no. 119 dated 29.09.2020, registered at Police Station Special Task Force, District Jalandhar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 21(c)/ 29/61/58 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

The petitioner having been in custody for more than three months, with the quantity of contraband stated to have been recovered from the car in which he was travelling (of which he is stated to be neither the owner nor the driver), is 270 grams of heroin, which is slightly above commercial quantity (the commercial quantity being 250 grams), and with there being no other criminal case registered against the petitioner, even as per the instructions of learned State counsel and further with the report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. having been already submitted to the competent court, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
