ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the impugned order dated 30.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) vide which bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner has been cancelled and forfeited.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is suffering from viral fever due to which he could not appear on 30.09.2021 before the trial Court due to which his bail bonds and surety bonds forfeited to State. He further submits that the petitioner is a poor person and even he is not in a condition to furnish fresh surety bonds before the learned Trial Court. The absence before the learned Trial Court was not intentional but only circumstantial.

In view of the aforesaid submission and given the nature of order being passed, he may furnish fresh bail bonds but surety bonds would suffice.

The petitioner shall put in appearance before the concerned Magistrate on 15.11.2021 and if for any reasons beyond his control in case he fails to put in appearance on 15.11.2021, he may finally appear on 22.11.2021. In case, he fails to appear on the said date then this order shall automatically stand recalled under Section 362 Cr.P.C. without indulgence of this Court.

The petition is allowed with the aforesaid terms.
